St. Martin of Tours Parish, Martinsville, Indiana has two cemeteries serving our parishioners and neighboring Catholics.

The Old Catholic Cemetery was established in 1848 at the site of the first Catholic church in Morgan County, St. Columban Church.

St. Martin of Tours Cemetery was established in 1962 at the site of our current parish church, St. Martin of Tours Church.

Catholics are eligible to purchase and be buried in one of our Catholic cemeteries. Plots may be purchased for a spouse, parents, children or siblings.

Non-Catholic relatives are eligible to be buried in one of our Catholic cemeteries.



The cost of one plot at either of our cemeteries is \$500 for St. Martin of Tours parishioners and \$1000 for Catholics from other Catholic parishes. Each plot may hold one casket or two urns.

Traditional burial of the body in a casket, or intact remains of the deceased in an urn, are to be placed in a vault in the cemetery plot.



The standard sizes of markers are: 24" x 12" x 4" for a single plot and 48" x 12" x 4" for a double plot.

Markers are to be of good quality marble, granite or cast bronze. Only sunken lettering is allowed.

Foundations are to be 20" deep with a 4" extension so that when the marker is set the marker will be no more than one half inch above ground level. The marker is to be leveled so that it follows the contour of the land.

Our decorating rules are posted at the entrance of St. Martin of Tours Cemetery. Copies of the cemetery rules are available at the parish office.
